### STUDYING ABROAD AS AN OUTBOUND EXCHANGE STUDENT

KMUTT has signed the Academic Agreement with more than 130 universities/ institutes abroad with the objective of promoting cooperation in the fields of education and academic research. The activities under the agreement are comprised of collaborative research, lectures, symposiums, exchange of information, materials, and researchers as well as undergraduate and graduate students. The student exchange program is a unique opportunity to study at partners universities. Students will experience different knowledge, diverse campus life and culture including well-built integrative learning skills, multi-cultural competencies, practical knowledge, self-confidence and lifelong friendships with people in different countries. This offers students the benefit to have better professional life in the future.

### LENGTH OF STUDY

KMUTT outbound exchange students are required to enroll at our partner universities for a minimum of one semester up to one academic year.

### TUITION AND FEES

By the agreement between KMUTT and partner universities, generally, exchange students will not be required to pay for tuition and fees while participating in the student exchange program. Expenses on transportation, meals, health insurance, life insurances and other expenses are paid by the exchange students. However, some partner universities may provide financial support upon request.

### PREPARING TO BE EXCHANGE STUDENT

1. Follow the deadline to apply by IA-KMUTT/or each university destination.
2. Required GPA at least 2.50 and never got PROBATION or F grade.
3. Consult your advisor on course registration to make sure about the credit transfer.
4. Complete the Application Form (by each university website) and prepare required documents.
  5. Submit the application package to IA through SoA+D office.
  6. Wait for the announcement of successful candidate.
7. If accepted, prepare to join the program by securing VISA, flight schedule and accommodation.

**\*Please note that the office of KMUTT registration will not accept the credit transfer which will be less than C grade\***
